Life Drawing

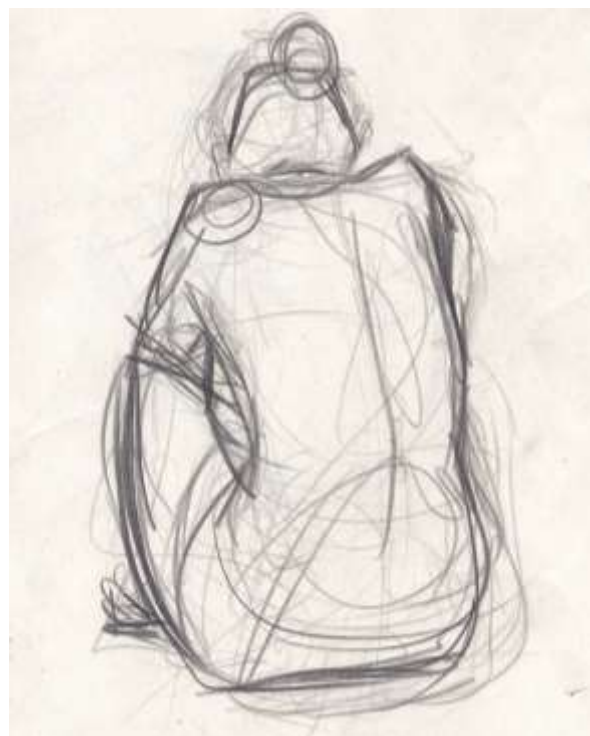
